## Introduction Page:

- Blank except for question and two buttons
  - Something like: Welcome to WUSTL Community Lost and Found! What brings you here?
    - I lost something :(
    - I found something!

## Lost Page

- Bar at the top with website name and back to landing button
- Feed with found items - this is immediately what you see
  - Each post has tags on it that describe what it is, making it easy to search
  - Post have name of item, location it was found, and a description of the item or a photo and name of the person who found it (hold the other side accountable to return)
  - Each post has a button that says claim this item!
    - Claim this item pop up:
      - Pop up says: this item has been put on hold at the location - pick up hours, how many days it will be on hold, contact phone number
- Hamburger Sidebar with search function - opens on touch (opens fully in mobile, partially in browser)
  - You can click/type popular tags (like in pinterest) and filter the lost item feed by the associated tags
  - Info about the location you go to pick up items - this is an icon in the top bar in mobile and listed at the bottom of sidebar in browser
  - Contact info for the location if you have questions - this is an icon in the top bar in mobile and listed at the bottom of sidebar in browser
    - Email, phone number, address or directions to get to building
  - Can search/filter by most recent posts
- Fixed Form submission at the top where you can submit a lost item - this opens with a button above the feed
  - Your name and email
  - Includes name of item
  - Location item was found
  - Description of item (or photo if you have one)
  - Submit button - click and replace with "submit another item" button
- Back to top button

- Back to landing page button

### Found Page

- Bar at the top with website name and back to landing button
- Similar to lost page but in reverse
- Button for Found submission form:
  - What did you find?
    - Your name and email
    - Item
    - Location
    - Description or photo
    - Tags
    - Submit button -click and make the form go away and replace with button "submit another item"
- Hamburger Sidebar with same content as lost page - opens on touch/click
  - Opens partially in browser and fully on mobile
  - with search function
    - You can click/type popular tags (like in pinterest) and filter the lost item feed by the associated tags
    - Info about the location you go to pick up items - this is an icon in the top bar in mobile and listed at the bottom of sidebar in browser
    - Contact info for the location if you have questions - this is an icon in the top bar in mobile and listed at the bottom of sidebar in browser
  - Can search/filter by most recent posts
- Lost item request feed - main content of page
  - Each post describes the item, has tags associated with it and the name of the person who lost it
  - Button that says "i found this item!"
    - Pop up that says - "Great! What is your name and email? (text boxes to fill out info) and then after submitting that: "The owner has been notified - please bring item to pick up location as soon as possible. Thanks!"
- Back to top button
- Back to landing page button

### Questions to think about:

- Does this include user profiles? Or is it all anonymous? Or do you just submit your name with each lost or found item?
  - Yes names are important because you need the human quality of it to create community
  - Do they need a photo?
- Names and emails of found item submitters are important to keep them accountable for returning the items
