

LOST & FOUND WEBSITE: outline

COLOR SCHEME: greens, grays, white
(subject to change)

HOMEPAGE:

- Screen divided into 2 sections
- “Lost something?” → which links to the Lost items page
- “Found something?” → which links to the submission page

LOST PAGE:

- MENU BAR: Lost page link; Found page link; Archives link
- SEARCH BAR: icon opens to search bar; also has ticks you can check with already considered tags (Electronics, Apparel, Wallets, Identification, Accessories, and Miscellaneous); maybe include color options too
- LAYOUT of the lost items
 - items listed in 2-5 columns depending on size of screen
 - just images in a square format
 - short summary of the items; when clicked will get full info
 - Location found, date, item description, contact info
 - Contact Button to directly contact

FOUND PAGE:

- MENU BAR (same as Lost page)
- LAYOUT: a form to fill out for the item found
 - Image
 - Category it falls under: Electronics, Apparel, Wallets, Identification, Accessories, and Miscellaneous
 - Item description: user types themselves
 - Location
 - Contact info (phone #, email, etc.)

**Valuables like Electronics, Wallets, and IDs will be specified to have less detailed info! It is up to the user to be the judge of worth ownership is true

ARCHIVES

- MENU BAR
- SEARCH BAR
- LAYOUT: same style as Lost page but when you hover over image, the date shows up

ITEM PAGE:

- LAYOUT: Image of object, date, description, location, contact info, and other info specified by the postee
